SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 6

Main Text: **(Hebrews 4:1-16)**

I. Introduction

- A. **(Psalm 139:7)** Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
- B. **(Romans 8:18)** For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
- C. **(Revelation 21:3)** And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.
(4) And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

II. The Rest of Christ Explained

- A. **(2 Peter 1:4)** “Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises:”
- B. **(John 14:2)** In my father’s house there are many mansions. If it were NOT so I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- C. **(Genesis 2:2)** And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.
- D. **(Revelation 14:13)** Blessed are the dead which die in the lord.

III. The Humanity of our High Priest

- A. **(Matthew 8:20)** And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.
- B. **(John 11:35)** Jesus wept.
- C. **(John 4:6)** Jesus therefore, being wearied with his journey, sat thus on the well.
- D. **(John 8:6)** This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him.
- E. **(Psalm 46:1)** God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.
