HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 8

Main Text: **(Hebrews 6:1-8)**

I. Introduction.

- A. (Philippians 3:12)** Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.
- B. (James 1:12)** Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
- C. (1 Corinthians 9:24)** Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.
- D. (Revelation 2:9)** I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, ***(but thou art rich)*** and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan. **(10)** Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

II. A Continued Call for Maturity.

- A. (2 Peter 1:12)** Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth.
- B. (Hebrews 10:4)** For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
- C. (Hebrews 11:6)** “But without faith it is impossible to please him.”
- D. (Job 19:26)** And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God:
- E. (Romans 5:1)** “Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:”
- F. (Titus 2:13)** Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;
- G. (Galatians 2:20)** I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
