HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 10

Main Text: **(Hebrews 7:1-11)**

I. Introduction

- A. **(Genesis 14:12)** And they took Lot, Abram's brother's son, who dwelt in Sodom, and his goods, and departed.
- B. **(Genesis 14:18)** And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

II. Melchizedek Is Greater Than Abraham.

- A. **(Genesis 14:19)** Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: **(20)** And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand.
- B. **(Hebrews 5:1)** For every high priest taken from among men is ordained for men in things pertaining to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins:
- C. **(Hebrews 5:4)** And no man taketh this honour unto himself, but he that is called of God, as was Aaron.
- D. **(Hebrews 11:4)** By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain,
- E. **(Psalms 110:1)** The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool
- F. **(Psalms 110:4)** The Lord hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.
- G. **(Hebrews 7:14)** For it is evident that our Lord sprang out of Juda; of which tribe Moses spake nothing concerning priesthood.
- H. **(Hebrews 4:14)** Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession.
- I. **(Hebrews 7:19)** For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God.
