Main Text: (Hebrews 11:4-5)

Supporting Text:

(Romans 10:17) So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

(Genesis 4:4) And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the Lord had respect unto Abel and to his offering:

(Genesis 4:5) But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

(Genesis 4:6) And the Lord said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?

(Genesis 4:7) If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

(Proverbs 27:4) Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?

(Matthew 27:18) For he knew of envy they had delivered him.

(1 John 3:11) For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

(John 13:35) By this shall the world know that you are my disciples IF, ye have love for one another.

(1 John 3:12) Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous.

(Genesis 5:22) And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:
