(Genesis 6:2) That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

(Matthew 22:29) Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. **(30)** For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven.
