SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 28

Main Text: (Hebrews 13:1-3)

Supporting Text:

- (John 13:34) A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.
- (**John 13:35**) By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- (James 4:11) Speak not evil of one another brethren. He that speaks against his brother speaks against the law.
- (James 1:19) Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:
- (1 Peter 3:8) Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:
- (2 Peter1:7) And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
- (Romans 12:13) Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.
- (1 John 3:16) Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
- (1 John 3:18) My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.
- **(Psalm 133:1)** Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!
- (Ephesians 4:32) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
- (1 John 4:20) If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?
- (1 John 4:21) And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.
