Main Text: **(Romans 3:20-31)**

Supporting Text:

(Hebrews 2:2) For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward;

(Galatians 3:21) Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law.

(Romans 9:31) But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. **(32)** Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone;

(Genesis 15:6) And he believed in the Lord; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

(2 Corinthians 5:21) For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

(1 Peter 1:18) Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; **(19)** But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

(1 John 2:2) And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

(1 Corinthians 2:11) For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

(Daniel 9:14) for the Lord our God is righteous in all his works which he doeth:

(Psalm 51:4) that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.

(Ephesians 2:9) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

(Hebrews 11:6) But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

(Matthew 5:17) Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
