WHEN YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND

Lean not on your own understanding. ~ Proverbs 3:5

It isn't easy to trust God when you're neck-deep in problems you don't understand. But that's what trust is—confidence in God, not in your own understanding.

Trust is certainty that God is in control when it seems that everything is out of control.
Trust is certainty that God is doing what is right when it seems that everything is going wrong.

Trust is certainty that God is present when it seems that he is absent.

Your understanding is limited. God's isn't. He knows what he is doing; you may not. He knows where he is taking you; you may not. He knows why; you may not.

So trust him, even when you don't understand.

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). FROM FAITH TO FAITH, PT. 10

Main Text: **(Romans 5:12-21)**

Supporting Text:

(Genesis 2:17) But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shall not eat of it: For in the day that thou eastest thereof thou shalt surely die.

(Genesis 3:6) And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

(James 4:17) Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

(Romans 3:23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

(Genesis 4:26) And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the Lord.

(Genesis 5:24) And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

(Jude 14) And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

(Hebrews 2:14) Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

(Hebrews 2:15) And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

(John 3:17) For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

(1 Corinthians 15:22) For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

(John 10:9) I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

(Hebrews 10:4) It's not possible that the blood of bulls and goats should take away sin.
