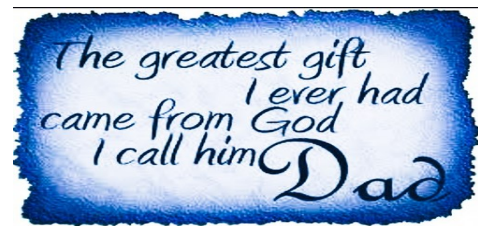

Main Text: **(Romans 8:26-39)**

Supporting Text:

(Hebrews 4:15) For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

(1 Samuel 16:7) For the Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart.

(1 John 5:14) And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us.

(1 Peter 2:21) For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

(1 Peter 2:23) Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

(1 Peter 2:22) Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

(Ephesians 4:15) But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

(Hebrews 2:11) For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

(Philippians 4:19) But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

(Matthew 6:32) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

(33) But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

(Romans 3:26) To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.
