FROM FAITH TO FAITH PT. 20

Main Text: **(Romans 12:1-2)**

Supporting Text:

(Lamentations 3:22) It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. **(23)** They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.

(1 Peter 2:5) Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

(Romans 6:12) Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. **(13)** Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

(Hebrews 13:15) By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. **(16)** But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

(Hebrews 5:8) Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; **(9)** And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

(Romans 3:23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

(James 4:4) know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

(John 18:36) My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.

(1 John 2:16) For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

(Romans 5:10) "when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, "

(Romans 8:29) For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
