Main Text: **(Romans 12:3-8)**

**(Ephesians 3:8)** Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

**(Galatians 1:13)** For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

**(Galatians 1:15)** But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace,

**(1 Timothy 1:12)** And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;

**(Romans 2:24)** For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you,

**(Romans 12:2)** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**(Ephesians 2:14)** For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

**(1 Corinthians 4:6)** And these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and to Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think of men above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.

**(1 Corinthians 4:7)** For who maketh thee to differ from another? and what hast thou that thou didst not receive? now if thou didst receive it, why dost thou glory, as if thou hadst not received it?

**(Romans 3:27)** Where is boasting then? It is excluded.
