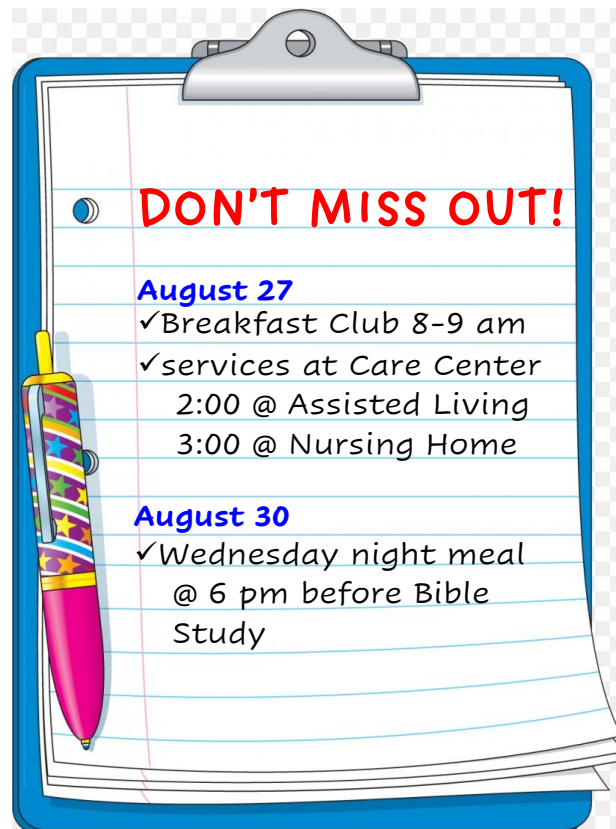
CONGRATULATIONS

FROM FAITH TO FAITH, PT. 24

Main Text: **(Romans 13:1-17)**

Supporting Text:

(Titus 3:1) Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, **(2)** To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.

(Daniel 2:20) Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: **(21)** And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:

(John 19:10) Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee? **(11)** Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.

(James 4:6) Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace to the humble. **(7)** Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

(1 Peter 2:9) But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light;

(1 Peter 2:11) strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; **(12)** Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

(1 Peter 2:15) For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

(John 18:36) My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.

(2 Peter 3:21) The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
