HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). EXAMINING THE INGREDIENTS OF AN ENCOURAGER

Main Text: (Acts 11:23-24)

SUPPORTING TEXTS:

- (James 5:9)** Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door.
- (James 5:16)** Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.
- (1 John 1:4)** And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.
- (Psalms 32:3)** When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long.
- (1 John 1:7)** But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- (1 John 2:1)** My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- (Matthew 10:34)** Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. **(35)** For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. **(36)** And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.
- (1 Corinthians 5:13)** Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.
- (Rom 8:38)** For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, **(39)** Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- (Isaiah 55:8-9)** For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. **(9)** For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- (Acts 20:32)** And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.
- (1 Thessalonians 4:18)** Wherefore comfort one another with these words.
