WHAT IS BETTER ACCORDING TO SOLOMON

Main Text: **(Ecclesiastes 7:1-11)**

Supporting Text:

(Proverbs 22:1) A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.

(Ecclesiastes 2:8) I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the delights of the sons of men, as musical instruments, and that of all sorts.

(Ecclesiastes 5:10) He that loveth silver shall not be satisfied with silver; nor he that loveth abundance with increase: this is also vanity.

(Ecclesiastes 5:11) When goods increase, they are increased that eat them: and what good is there to the owners thereof, saving the beholding of them with their eyes?

(Ecclesiastes 5:12) The sleep of a labouring man is sweet, whether he eat little or much: but the abundance of the rich will not suffer him to sleep.

(1 Kings 2:2) I go the way of all the earth: be thou strong therefore, and shew thyself a man;

(Hebrews 9:27) And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

(Ecclesiastes 3:1) There is a time to every purpose under heaven.

(Ecclesiastes 7:3) Sorrow is better than laughter: for by the sadness of the countenance the heart is made better.

(Ecclesiastes 7:4) The heart of the wise is in the house of mourning; but the heart of fools is in the house of mirth.
