Main Text: **(Genesis 37:11)**

Supporting Text:

(Proverbs 27:4) Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?

(Genesis 37:14) “And he said to him, Go, I pray thee, see whether it be well with thy brethren, and well with the flocks; and bring me word again.”

(Genesis 37:6) And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed: **(7)** For, behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf.

(Genesis 42:21) And they said one to another, We are verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

(Genesis 17:18) And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee!

(Genesis 17:20) And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.

(Genesis 42:36) And Jacob their father said unto them, Me have ye bereaved of my children: Joseph is not, and Simeon is not, and ye will take Benjamin away: all these things are against me.

(1 Samuel 16:7) “Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart.”
