This week we'll celebrate the national holiday of Thanksgiving. It is a time of reflection and thankfulness for our countless blessings. HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16).
