(Luke 12:15) And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

(Revelation 2:9) I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich).

(James 1:9) Let the brother of low degree rejoice in that he is exalted.
