HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). Main Text: (Matthew 22:1-14)

Supporting Text:

- (Galatians 4:4) But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law.
- (Isaiash 1:18) Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.
- (Amos 2:12) But ye gave the Nazarites wine to drink; and commanded the prophets, saying, Prophesy not.
- (**Jeremiah 6:16**) Thus saith the Lord, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.
- (John 8:39-41) If ye were Abraham's children you would do the works of Abraham. (But ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God, this did NOT Abraham.) (41) You do the deeds of your father.)
- (Romans 1:28) And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;
- (Luke 8:12) Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- (2 Corinthians 5:21) For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
- (Revelation 3:1) I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.
- (Revelation 3:5) He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels
