WHEN WEAK LET ME SEEK

Main Text: (Matthew 26-27)

Supporting Text:

- (Luke 23:44) And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.
- (Matthew 26:39) And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.
- (John 18:4) Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, Whom seek ye? (5) They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them. (6) As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward, and fell to the ground.
- (Matthew 26:52) Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. (53) Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels? (54) But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?
- **(Romans 8:18)** For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
- (Matthew 27:40) And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross.
- (Matthew 27:46) Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?
- (Psalm 22:1) My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?
- **(Psalm 22:7)** All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,
- **(Psalm 22:8)** He trusted on the Lord that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.
- **(Psalm 22:24)** For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard.
- (Luke 23:34) Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.
