

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). THE HARD SAYINGS OF JESUS, PART 2

Main Text: (Matthew 5:43-48)

Supporting Text:

- (Leviticus 19:17) Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart: thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbour, and not suffer sin upon him.
- (Leviticus 19:18) Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the Lord.
- (Leviticus 18:3) After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: and after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do: neither shall ye walk in their ordinances.
- **(Deuteronomy 18:9)** When thou art come into the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.
- (**Deuteronomy 14:2)** For thou art an holy people unto the Lord thy God, and the Lord hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth.
- (**Deuteronomy 7:7)** The Lord did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people:
- (Deuteronomy 9:4) Speak not thou in thine heart, after that the Lord thy God hath cast them out from before thee, saying, For my righteousness the Lord hath brought me in to possess this land: but for the <u>wickedness of these</u> <u>nations</u> the Lord doth drive them out from before thee.
- (Isaiah 42:6) I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles.
- (Romans 1:28) And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;
- (Romans 12:20) Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.
- (Ephesians 5:1) Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children;
- (Romans 3:23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- (Romans 5:8) But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
