DID JESUS WORRY?

At the end of a Bible class on "Your Faith Can Overcome Worry," a comment was made and question asked about Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane. As He anticipated the horrendous suffering that He was about to endure, was He worried about it? Did He violate His own instructions about "do not worry" (cf. Matthew 6:25, 31, 34; Philippians 4:6)?

There is no doubt that Jesus was "troubled," "deeply distressed," "exceedingly sorrowful," "in agony" and shouting out with "vehement cries and tears" (Mark 14:33; Matthew 26:38-44; Luke 22:44; Hebrews 5:7). But, was He worrying about the hours ahead? There is a difference between concerned anguish and fretful worry. Two things indicate that Jesus was not worrying: First, Jesus was trusting in His Father ("not My will, but Yours, be done," Luke 22:42), and second, Jesus got up and did what needed to be done ("Rise, let us be going," Matthew 26:46).

To avoid worry, follow Jesus' example: Build your trust in your Father and get up and do what needs to be done.

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). If you would like to further study this question of "What must I do to be saved?", please see our minister or one of our elders.

SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 3

Main Text: (Hebrews 2:1-4)

I. How To Prevent Slipping.

- **A.** (Luke 24:26) Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?
- **B.** (1 Corinthians 15:3) For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; (4) And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:
- C. (Titus 2:13) Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;
- **D.** (2 Thessalonians 1:8) In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- **E.** (**Hebrews 6:19**) Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

II. How To Escape.

- **A.** (Acts 7:38) This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sina, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us:
- **B.** (Romans 7:7) What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.
- **C.** (Numbers 15:32) And while the children of Israel were in the wilderness, they found a man that gathered sticks upon the sabbath day.
- **D.** (Numbers 15:36) And all the congregation brought him without the camp, and stoned him with stones, and he died; as the Lord commanded Moses.
- **E.** (James 1:18) Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.
- **F.** (Psalm 8:4) What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?
