### IT'S OK TO NOT HAVE ALL THE ANSWERS, AS LONG AS WE KNOW . . .

Sometimes things happen and we want to know, "Why?" We look and search and dig and wonder and fret and worry about the "Why?" We get so desperate sometimes that we start to make up reasons and explanations in our minds to satisfy our search for "Why?" Oftentimes (and almost always) those reasons and explanations are not well-founded and cause us to settle our thoughts on some conclusions that have no (or very little) basis.

We would do well to remind and convince ourselves that it is ok to not have all the answers (i.e., all the reasons) when bad things happen. Unfortunately, the truth is that "time and chance happen to...all" (Ecclesiastes 9:11). It does NOT mean that God is not there (Hebrews 13:5). It does NOT mean that God does not care (1 Peter 5:7). Rather than dwell on what we do not know, let us dwell on what we do know: God is (Hebrews 11:6). God knows (Matthew 6:8). God loves (Romans 8:31-39). God cares (Philippians 4:6-7). God can (Ephesians 3:20-21). God will (Romans 8:28). Let us trust Him (Proverbs 3:5-6)!

# HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). ### SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 4

Main Text: (Hebrews 2:10-18)

# **I.** What Christians Are Presently.

- **A.** (John 1:3) All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made.
- **B.** (1 John 3:1) Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God:
- **C.** (**Hebrews 5:9**) And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;
- **D.** (1 Timothy 2:5) For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- **E.** (Matthew 12:50) For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.

# **II.** Our Riches by His Poverty.

- **A.** (Acts 2:25) For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:
- **B.** (Acts 2:31) He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.
- **C.** (**Isaiah 53:5**) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- **D.** (Isaiah 53:9) And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.
- **E. (2 Corinthians 5:21)** For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
- **F.** (Romans 6:23) For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- **G.** (Revelation 1:18) I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.
