SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT.

Main Text: (Hebrews 5:1-14)

I. Introduction.

- **A.** (Exodus 19:4) Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and how I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself. (5) Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: (6) And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation.
- **B.** (**Deuteronomy 4:6**) Keep therefore and do them; for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.
- **C.** (1 Samuel 6:4) "Five golden emerods, and five golden mice." The trespass offering of the Philistines differs from what GOD reveals to Israel in (Leviticus 5) for acceptable trespass offerings.

II. Jesus Our High Priest.

- **A.** (Romans 5:12) Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:
- **B.** (**Hebews 2:9**) "That he by the grace of God should taste death for every man."
- **C.** (John 10:11) I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.
- **D.** (**Hebrews 4:15**) "but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin."
- E. (Hebrews 12:2) "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith."

III. A Call for Maturity.

- **A.** (1 Peter 2:2) As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:
- **B.** (2 Peter 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness,
