To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9–10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 9

Main Text: (Hebrews 6:9-20)

I. The Unwavering Promises of God.

- **A.** (Colossians 3:1) If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. (2) Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.
- B. (Genesis 30:28) And he said appoint me thy wages, and I will give it.
- **C.** (**John 13:35**) By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- **D.** (Romans 8:24) "For we are saved by hope:"
- **E.** (Romans 12:11) Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;
- F. (Matthew 25:26) "Thou wicked and slothful servant,"
- **G.** (**Hebrews 11:1**) Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- **H.** (Genesis 15:13) And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years; (14) And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.
- **I.** (**Titus 1:2**) In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;
- **J.** (2 Peter 3:9) The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- **K.** (1 John 1:5) This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.
- L. (1 Kings 2:29) And it was told king Solomon that Joab was fled unto the tabernacle of the Lord; and, behold, he is by the altar. Then Solomon sent Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, saying, Go, fall upon him.
