To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 15

Main Text: (Hebrews 10:1-39)

I. Hold On. Fight The Good Fight of Faith.

- A. (2 Timothy 1:7) "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear;"
- **B.** (1 Peter 1:10) Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:
- **C. (Hebrews 3:6)** "But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we,"
- **D.** (James 1:8) A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
- **E.** (Hebrews 6:18) "That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie,"
- **F. (Hebrews 3:13)** But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

II. The Agony of Apostasy.

- **A. (Romans 6:1)** What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?
- **B.** (Romans 6:2) God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- **C.** (1 John 2:1) My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- **D.** (Hebrews 6:4) For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,
- **E.** (Hebrews 6:6) If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame
- **F. (Romans 12:19)** Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- **G.** (2 Thessalonians 1:8) In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
