


HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 16

Main Text: (Hebrews 11:1-3) (Hebrews 11:35-39)

I. Supporting Text:

- **(Hebrews 10: 23)** Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)
- **(Hebrews 6:10)** For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.
- (Habakkuk 2:4) Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: "but the just shall live by his faith."
- (Luke 9:62) "No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."
- **(Hebrews 6:19)** Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;
- (Genesis 1:1) In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- (Romans1:19) Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.
- (Romans 1:20) For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:
- **(Psalm 33: 6)** By the word of the Lord were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.
- **(Psalm 19:1)** The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
- (Psalm 19:2) Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge.
- (Psalm 19:3) There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.
