To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 22 (The Hall of Faith)

Main Text: (Hebrews 11:33-34)

Supporting Text:

(Joshua 6:1) Now Jericho was straitly shut up because of the children of Israel: none went out, and none came in.

(Joshua 6:2) And the Lord said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour.

(Hebrews 3:14) For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

(Ephesians 2:8) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

(Proverbs 12:22) Lying lips are abomination to the Lord: but they that deal truly are his delight.

(Proverbs 6:16) These six things doth the Lord hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: **(17)** A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,

(Proverbs 14:5) A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies.

(Leviticus 19:11) Ye shall not steal, neither deal falsely, neither lie one to another.

(Joshua 2:10) For we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.

(Joshua 2:11) And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the Lord your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

(Hebrews 2:14) Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

(Hebrews 2:15) And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
