To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). Main Text: (Hebrews 12:1-3)

Supporting Text:

- (**Hebrews 11:39**) And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: **(40)** God having provided some better thing for us,
- (1 John 4:18) There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
- **(Hebrews 6:18)** That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie.
- **(Hebrews 2:1)** Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip."
- (1 Peter 5:7) Casting all your care upon him: for he careth for you.
- **(Hebrews 3:12)** Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
- (1 Corinthians 9:24) "Know ye not that they which run in a race run all." "So run, that ye may obtain."
- (Matthew 6:22) The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.
- (Matthew 6:23) But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!"
