WHAT'S ON YOUR AGENDA FOR TODAY?

You don't know what the day will bring ~ Proverbs 27:1

What's on your agenda today? Travel? Work? Meetings? Shopping? Cleaning? You brush your teeth, put on your clothes, and grab your to-do list—set on conquering your busy world by lunchtime.

But it only takes one phone call to blow your plans to bits. An illness, an accident—even a chatty friend can rewrite the script. "You don't know what the day will bring."

You have big plans. Nothing wrong with that. But don't overlook the possibility that the seemingly insignificant may be the most important thing you do today: the affirmation of a friend, the hospital visit—or the longer-than-intended phone conversation.

God knows who needs encouragement—and he may use you to deliver that blessing.

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). (Ecclesiastes 7:29) Lo, this only have I found, that God hath made man upright; but they have sought out many inventions.
