FROM FAITH TO FAITH PT. 5

Main Text: **(Romans 2:17-29)**

Supporting Text:

(Luke 18:11) The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. **(12)** I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

(Romans 7:7) What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.

(Matthew 15:14) Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.

(Malachi 3:8) Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

(Jeremiah 5:7) How shall I pardon thee for this? thy children have forsaken me, and sworn by them that are no gods: when I had fed them to the full, they then committed adultery, and assembled themselves by troops in the harlots' houses. **(8)** They were as fed horses in the morning: everyone neighed after his neighbour's wife. **(9)** Shall I not visit for these things?

(Isaiah 52:5) Now therefore, what have I here, saith the Lord, that my people is taken away for nought? they that rule over them make them to howl, saith the Lord; and my name continually every day is blasphemed.

(Isaiah 42:6) I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles.

(Matthew 5:14) Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. **(15)** Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. **(16)** Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

(Revelation 3:1) I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

(Matthew 12:41) The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

(Deuteronomy 10:16) Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked.
