HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1–2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9–10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). FROM FAITH TO FAITH, PT. 9

Main Text: **(Romans 5:1-11)**

Supporting Text:

- (Philippians 4:7) And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- (Philippians 4:13) I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
- (**Hebrew 12:18**) For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest,
- (Hebrew 12:22) But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,
- (**Hebrew 10:19**) Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,
- (**Hebrew 10:22**) Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.
- (Romans 8:1) There is now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the spirit.
- (Galatians 6:14) But GOD forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord JESUS Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.
- (John 16:33) These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.
- (James 1:2) Count it all JOY when ye fall into divers' temptations (3) knowing that the trying of your faith worketh patience. (4) But let patience have her perfect work that ye may be perfect and entire wanting nothing.
- (Isaiah 1:5) Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint.
- (**Isaiah 1:6**) From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not been closed, neither bound up, neither mollified with ointment.
