HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). FROM FAITH TO FAITH, PT. 12

Main Text: (Romans 6:15-23)

Supporting Text:

- (1 John 3:4) Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.
- (James 1:25) But whose looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- (Ephesians 4:24) And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
- (Matthew 5:3) Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- (John 8:24) for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.
- (**John 3:16**) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him.
- (1 Corinthians 6:9) Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, (10) Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. (11) And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
- (Ephesians 5:13) But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.
- (**Ephesians 5:14**) Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.
- (2 Timothy 1:7) For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- (Hebrews 12:14) Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:
- (Colossians 3:24) Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.
