


# **WEDNESDAY NIGHT MEALS**

Main Text: (1 Thessalonians 1:6-10)

# **Supporting Text:**

- (Revelation 3:17) They said to themselves, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing.
- (Revelation 3:20) Jesus says: Behold I stand at the door and knock.
- (Romans 8:29) For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son,
- (2 Corinthians 3:18) But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image: from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- (Acts 17:16) Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry.
- (Galatians 2:20) I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless, I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- (Matthew 24:42) Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.
- (Matthew 24:44) Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
- (Matthew 24:46) Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:2) For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:6) Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:8) But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.
