To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). Main Text: (Romans 12:14, 17-21)

Supporting Text:

- (Luke 6:28) Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.
- (Matthew 5:11) Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. (12) Rejoice and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.
- (2 Timothy 3:12) Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.
- (1 Peter 2:21) For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: (22) Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: (23) Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:
- **(Philippians 4:8)** Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.
- (1 Corinthians 4:12) "being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we suffer it:"
- (Romans 12:2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- (1 Timothy 2:1) I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; (2) For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- (Matthew 27:39) And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads, (40) And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross.
- (Matthew 5:5) Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- (Romans 5:10) "For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son,"
