Main Text: (Romans 15:1-13)

Supporting Text:

- (Luke 24:26) Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?
- (1 Thessalonians 5:14) Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.
- (John 6:38) For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- (Philippians 2:7) But made himself of no reputation and took upon him the form of a servant.
- **(Psalm 69:30)** I will praise the name of God with a song and will magnify him with thanksgiving.
- (Hebrews 12:1) Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,
- (John 12:32) And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.
- (John 17:21) That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
