

CARE CENTER SERVICES




APPRECIATION DINNER

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). SO WHY DO YOU BELIEVE IN THE BIBLE?

Main Text: (2 Timothy 3:16)

Supporting Text:

- (1 John 1:5) This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.
- (Job 14:1) Man that is born of a woman is of few days and full of trouble.
- (Ecclesiastes 9:11) "but time and chance happeneth to them all."
- (Isaiah 7:14) Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.
- (Psalm 22:1) My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?
- (Psalm 22:8) He trusted on the Lord that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.
- (Daniel 2:44) And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.
- (Micah 5:2) But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.
- (Isaiah 53:5) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- **(Psalm 139:14)** I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well.
- (Ecclesisastes 7:29) Lo, this only have I found, that God hath made man upright; but they have sought out many inventions.
- (Isaiah 64:6) But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
- (Romans 7:24) O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?
