

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

OBSERVATIONS FROM OBADIAH

Main Text: (Obadiah 1:3, 10, 17)

Supporting Text:

(Proverbs 11:2) "When pride cometh, then cometh shame:"

(Proverbs 13:10) "Only by pride cometh contention:"

(Proverbs 16:5) "Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the Lord:"

(Proverbs 16:18) Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.

(Proverbs 29:23) "A man's pride shall bring him low:"

(Genesis 27:40) "And by thy sword shalt thou live."

(2 Thessalonians 1:8) In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:

(Matthew 5:3) Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

- (Habakkuk 1:3) spoiling and violence are before me: and there are that raise up strife and contention.
- (Habakkuk1:4) Therefore the law is slacked, and judgment doth never go forth: for the wicked doth compass about the righteous; therefore, wrong judgment proceeds.
- (Psalm 137:7) Remember, O Lord, the children of Edom in the day of Jerusalem; who said, Rase it, rase it, even to the foundation thereof.
- (Lamentations 2:15) All that pass by clap their hands at thee; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying, Is this the city that men call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?
- (Romans 12:15) Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.
- (Ephesians 4:31) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: **(32)** And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
- (John 4:23) But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
