

Main Text: (John 6:35)

Supporting Text:

- (**John 3:2**) Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.
- (**Deuteronomy 18:15**) The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;
- (**John 18:36**) Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.
- (James 1:17) Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.
- (Matthew 26:52) Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. (53) Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels? (54) But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?
- (Matthew 6:19) Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: (20) "But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven,"
- (Romans 4:2) For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before God. (4) Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. (5) But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.
- (Matthew 5:6) Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
