

In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9–10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). MAIN TEXT: (2 Kings 5:1-14)

SUPPORTING TEXT:

- (Luke 4:27) And many lepers were in Israel in the time of Eliseus the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, saving Naaman the Syrian.
- (**Proverbs 14:12**) There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.
- (Isaiah 55:8) For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord.
- (1 Corinthians 1:25) Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.
- (2 John 9) He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.
- (Ephesians 1:3) Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:
- (Romans 6:4) Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. (5) For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:
- (1 Peter 3:21) The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
- (Acts 22:16) And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
- (Galatians 3:27) For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
