HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Main Text: (James 1:12-18)

Supporting Text:

- (Matthew 24:13) But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.
- (1 Corinthians 9:24) Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain. (25) And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.
- (1 John 1:5) This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.
- (Ecclesiastes 7:29) Lo, this only have I found, that God hath made man upright; but they have sought out many inventions.
- (**Proverbs 4:23**) Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.
- (1 John 2:15) Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (16) For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- (Romans 13:14) But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.

- (Genesis 3:15) And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.
