- If you have any questions concerning our services or the church or the Bible, we encourage you to speak to our minister or one of our elders.

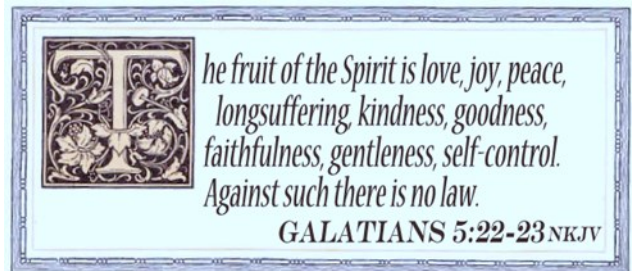
FREE BREAKFAST
