

**(1 Corinthians 6:13)** “Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats:”

**(Proverbs 7:21)** With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.

**(Proverbs 7:22)** He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;

**(Proverbs 7:23)** Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hasteth to the snare, and knoweth not that it is for his life.

**(Proverbs 7:24)** Hearken unto me now therefore, O ye children, and attend to the words of my mouth.

**(1 Kings 2:2)** I go the way of all the earth: be thou strong therefore, and shew thyself a man; **(3)** And keep the charge of the Lord thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

**(Hosea 7:5)** In the day of our king the princes have made him sick with bottles of wine; he stretched out his hand with scorners.

**(Leviticus 19:14)** Thou shalt not curse the deaf, nor put a stumblingblock before the blind, but shalt fear thy God: I am the Lord.
