
- Please pick up an information packet from our welcome table in the lobby. We also have a small gift for our first-time guests.

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Main Text: (James 5:7-12)

Supporting Text:

- (2 Peter 1:6) "And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience."
- (James 1:2) My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;(3) Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. (4) But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.
- (Matthew 24:44) Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
- (Matthew 24:45) Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?
- (Matthew 24:46) Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- (Hebrews 11:37) They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented; (38) (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.
- (Matthew 5:10) Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (11) Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. (12) Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.
- (Job 1:22) In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- (Job 13:13) Hold your peace, let me alone, that I may speak, and let come on me what will.
- (Job 13:14) Wherefore do I take my flesh in my teeth, and put my life in mine hand? (15) Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him: but I will maintain mine own ways before him.
- (Romans 8:18) For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
