Main Text: (1 Corinthians 8:1-13)

Supporting Text:

- (1 Corinthians 1:20) Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?
- (**John 13:35**) By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- (**Hebrews 10:19**) Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus
- (Galatians 5:1) Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- (Galatians 5:13) For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.
- (1 Peter 2:16) As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.
- (**Philippians 2:1**) If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,
- (Philippians 2:5) Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:
- (Romans 14:20) For meat destroy not the work of God. All things indeed are pure; but it is evil for that man who eateth with offence.
