# STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE, PT. 14

Main Text: **(1 Corinthians 9:19-27)**

## Supporting Text:

**(Romans 14:4)** “Who art thou that judgest another man's servant?”

**(Matthew 5:16)** Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

**(Galatians 1:10)** For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

**(2 Timothy 2:10)** Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

**(Romans 8:18)** For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

**(2 Timothy 4:6)** For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. **(7)** I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: **(8)** Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

## HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16).
