

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE, PT. 15

Main Text: (1 Corinthians 10:1-13)

Supporting Text:

- **(Exodus 16:4)** the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or no.
- (Exodus 16:5) And it shall come to pass, that on the sixth day they shall prepare that which they bring in; and it shall be twice as much as they gather daily.
- (Matthew 23:37) O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!
- (**Philippians 2:8**) And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
- (Exodus 32:26) Who is on the Lord's side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.
- (Exodus 32:27) And he said unto them, Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.
- (Exodus 32:28) And the children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day about three thousand men.
- (Romans 15:4) "For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning."
- (1 John 5:13) These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
- (1 Corinthians 8:1) we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth.
