HOW TO COMPLETE THE RACE OF FAITH

Main Text: (Heb 12:1-3)

Supporting Text:

- (1 John 4:18) There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
- (Heb 6:18) That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie.
- (Heb 2:1) Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.
- (Eph 4:31) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:
- (1 Pet 5:7) Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
- (Heb 3:12) Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
- (Matt 6:23) Thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness.
- (Rom 8:18) For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
- (John 15:19) If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.
- (John 15:20) Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- (Gal 6:9) And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
- (Isa 26:3) Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. (4) Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the Lord Jehovah is everlasting strength
