HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). THE SERVANT SPIRIT

If you need a mission statement, you couldn't do better than adopt and adapt Jesus' words. Put it this way: I am not in this world to be served; I am in this world to serve.

Today, you may cross paths with someone who is hurting. You will have to be alert to spot it and will have to pray for wisdom to know how to deal with it.

Here are some words that will put you on the right track: "Instead of being motivated by selfish ambition or vanity, each of you should, in humility, be moved to treat one another as more important than yourself. Each of you should be concerned not only about your own interests, but about the interests of others as well" (Phil 2:3–4 NET).

- (Galatians 6:14) But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.
- (Romans 6:20) For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness.
- (Romans 6:21) What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.
- (John 16:33) These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
- (1 Peter5:7) Casting all you care upon HIM, for HE cares for you.
