# **STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE PT. 16**

## **Main Text (1 Corinthians 11:1-16)**

### **Supporting Text:**

**(Ephesians 5:23)** For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

**(Philippians 2:6)** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: **(7)** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: **(8)** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

**(Joel 2:28)** “And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy.”

**(Acts 2:39)** For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

**(Genesis 1:26)** “Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.”

**(Genesis 2:7):** And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

**(Genesis 2:23)** “This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.”

**(Genesis 3:20)** And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

**(Colossians 3:23)** And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

### **HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN**

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16).
