following morning services in the church basement. Lunch will be provided. There will be a treasure hunt, pirate battle, princess pampering, and more.

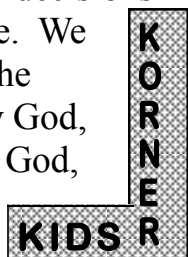
MEN'S STUDY GROUP
